If the following questions are not answered as indicated, it is considered a discrepancy and your application will not be processed. If you already have an associate's and/or bachelor's degree, you are still required to answer as follows:</p> <p><i>#29: What will your college grade level be when you begin the school year?</i> Answer: Attended College Before/1st Yr. ONLY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * You must renew your FAFSA during your freshman year at Le Moyne College (LMC) with the <i>Filing Requirements</i> listed above * SJCON scholarship application is due February 1 of your LMC freshman year * Award letters are released after your LMC spring semester – mid-June * Le Moyne scholarships/grants do not carry over for Year II & III * Pell, TAP, and/or Direct Loans are similar to your LMC Year I offer * SJCON will add any LMC tuition and room/board charges during Year II & III * Pell/TAP is based on SJCON's curriculum, LMC electives do not count towards fulltime status * Some private lenders do not work with SJCON as they do with LMC (recommended to use ELMSelect to research private lenders)

Accelerated) ONLY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * You must submit your FAFSA with the Filing Requirements listed above * Award letters are released in early Spring * SJCON processes federal/state applications * You need to contact Le Moyne College for billing information. Billing and financial aid are processed separately for this option. You will need two separate private loans as we cannot send funds between the colleges.
