- Personal Statement/Essay
- Two (2) Letters of Recommendation

\* Courses can be completed at our affiliate Le Moyne College, or at other colleges. St. Joseph's maintains transfer credit agreements with several online and regional colleges including Portage Learning, Onondaga Community College, and Cayuga Community College. General Education courses must be similar in content, rigor and expected learning outcomes with a minimum grade of "C" (2.0) to be considered for transfer credit. Refer to Catalog for "Transfer Credit Policy". It is strongly suggested General Education courses be completed prior to enrollment. Refer to our catalog for all pre/co-requisite requirements.

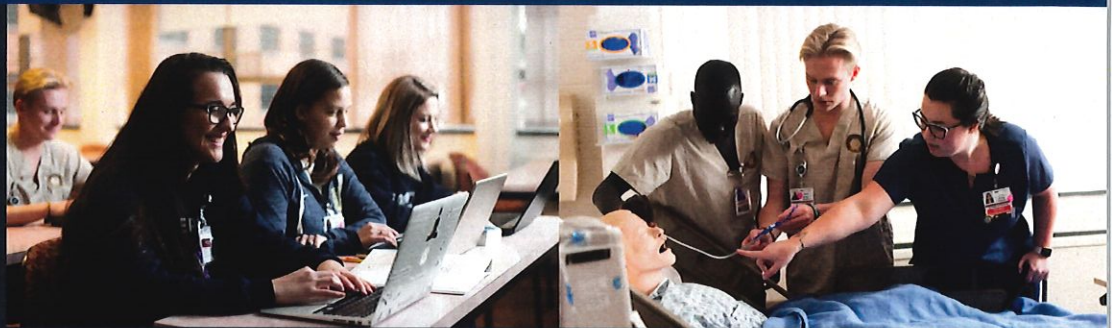
